...support the group and members of it through appropriate use of communications and social media, and not use those tools as a distraction or create situations that could hurt the group or individuals		
...be academically eligible for first semester by passing at least 5 hours of classes during 2nd semester of the previous school year		
...be on time for class rehearsals that start at 7:00 am during marching season (start of school through end of October)		
...participate in all Marching Band events unless excused, sick, or an emergency arises		
...attend small number of director-scheduled rehearsals that are outside the school day except in the case of excused conflicts		
...attend student leader-scheduled sectional rehearsals except in the case of excused conflicts		
...strive to communicate and work well with others in his/her section and the band to achieve cooperative group success		
...consistently give effort and work to improve the physical skills associated with marching band
